This document was created by the Institute of National Anti-Doping Organisations (iNADO) with support from the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), as well as with input from iNADO member National Anti-Doping Organizations (NADOs) and Regional Anti-Doping Organizations (RADOs). This overview of connects directly to iNADO's strategic priority "Improving Practice Everywhere" and specifically the strategic activity "Connect Members for Support".

The purpose of this "**Overview of Collaboration Projects among ADOs**" is to provide Anti-Doping Organizations (ADOs) with clear information about which organizations support and collaborate around different anti-doping areas, such as testing, training for doping controls, education, legal and results management, code compliance, as well as other areas. In addition, the intention is for iNADO members and the anti-doping community to use this as a resource to connect with other ADOs that can either provide support and/or mutual exchange on specific topics.

The tables below show region (of the ADO receiving support), countries of the ADOs involved, areas of support, and duration of every collaboration project that was known to iNADO during the information gathering phase (first months of 2023). A distinction is made between collaboration agreements for capacity building purposes (in green) and those whose purpose is to exchange information for the benefit of all parties, or which are formed as a collaboration network (in blue). The first are regularly comprised by one ADO providing support to another.

The overview is not exhaustive, and we encourage our members and other ADOs to share with iNADO additional support, collaboration and mutual exchange that is happening.





Anti-Doping areas part of all collaboration agreements (for both purposes of capacity building and mutual exchange of information).




Collaboration agreements per region

Regions where collaboration agreements for purposes of capacity building are taking place (according to the region of the ADO receiving support).




